Call for applications: Amirana Scholarship Fund

Scholarships available for university applicants for Medicine from developing countries and newly industrializing nations

The Amirana Scholarship Fund, which was set up by Heidelberg University alumni in 2016, offers scholarships to applicants from developing countries and newly industrializing nations (c.f. [DAC List](#)) pursuing degrees in Medicine and Dentistry who would not be able to study in Germany without financial support.

The scholarship application must also include the following supporting documents/certificates:

- CV with photo
- Motivation letter
- Description of education received up to now, school degrees, activities, etc.
- Explanation of finances and living situation
- Certificate of enrolment (can be submitted at a later date; admission to the program is a requirement to receive support)
- Disclosure of whether the applicant has applied elsewhere for scholarships
- Scan of current bank statement

Funding requirements and scope:

The scholarship from the Scholarship Fund is awarded for Medicine study programs at Heidelberg University. Those interested from developing countries and newly industrializing nations (c.f. [DAC List](#)) who have been accepted to the Medical Faculty in Mannheim are eligible to apply. In general, funding of EUR 300 to EUR 600 per month is possible. Support is dependent on the level of need of the applicant and the resources available for distribution from the Scholarship Fund. The support will be evaluated regularly and adapted to the personal situation. The funding is bound to the successful completion of the study program.
